

## Psalm 27

**For he will hide me under his shelter in the day of trouble:**

**and conceal me in the shadow of his tent, and set me high upon a rock.**

And now he will lift up my head: above my enemies round about me.

**And I will offer sacrifices in his sanctuary with exultation:**

**I will sing, I will sing praises to the Lord.**

O Lord, hear my voice when I cry: have mercy upon me and answer me.

**My heart has said of you, 'Seek his face': your face, Lord, I will seek.**

Do not hide your face from me: or thrust your servant aside in displeasure;

**For you have been my helper: do not cast me away or forsake me, O God of my salvation.**

Though my father and my mother forsake me: the Lord will take me up.

**Teach me your way, O Lord: and lead me in an even path, for they lie in wait for me.**

Do not give me over to the will of my enemies: for false witnesses have risen against me, and those who breathe out violence.

**But I believe that I shall surely see the goodness of the Lord: in the land of the living.**

O wait for the Lord; stand firm and he will strengthen your heart: and wait, I say, for the Lord.
